

Rebecca Allup-Carlen

Master of Arts in Christian Leadership, Class of 2020



Rebecca Allup-Carlen is an alumna of Manna U (Formerly Grace College of Divinity) as well as a staff member who works with Manna U Latin America. We asked her some questions about what she learned at Manna University as a student and about the work she does as a staff member and instructor for courses offered in Spanish to students in Latin America and Spanish-speakers in the United States. She spoke about how as a dental hygienist she has the opportunity to show people the love of God in a context where they normally are uncomfortable. Rebecca shared, "I learned at Manna U that you don't have to be serving in missions or inside a church, but that I can bring the Kingdom of God to my workplace."

Then Rebecca elaborated on how Manna U Latin America came to exist, what she has seen, and the work she gets to affect, "It started in 2016 when Dr. Crowther started an institute in Colombia to train pastors," but eventually, graduates of the institute wanted to progress further. They wanted to be part of Manna University, so work began in the Autumn of 2022, and in Spring of 2023, Manna U offered its first courses entirely in Spanish.

"The students' tenacity impresses me," Rebecca expounded, "as they have to overcome a lot, but if they are looking to get gold out of the courses, they are going to be challenged." Most of all, Rebecca described how grateful she feels to be part of bringing the classes that have changed her life to other Spanish-speakers and how grateful she is at how people have supported the cause. "Most of our students come on scholarships which are made possible by generous donors to Manna U. All of our students are leaders in their churches and communities. They are using what they learn from us to train up other leaders around them."



Mason Kerby's Manna U Journey: Navigating Faith and Leadership

In the heart of Abilene, Texas, current Manna U Major Mason Kerby, shares his transformative journey while studying at Manna University, emphasizing the profound impact of his time on his faith and leadership. Initially hesitant about online education, Mason's perspective changed during a conversation with his pastor, David McQueen, in high school, which led him to apply to Manna U. Through classes like Destiny and Calling, he recognized the universal call to ministry and embraced the principle that "God equips the called."

The unexpected connection with Manna U arose from a friendship between Pastor David McQueen and Manna Church's lead pastor, Chris Fletcher, who is also a professor and board member at Manna U.

This connection played a pivotal role in Mason's decision to pursue education at Manna U. Delving into his calling, Mason found the Applied Instrumental Techniques class to be a transformative experience, enhancing his vocal abilities and instilling newfound confidence.

Reflecting on the impact of the diverse curriculum, Mason expresses, "I finally feel confident in my singing, and that would have never happened if Manna U didn't offer lessons." Despite juggling work, a full class load, and navigating a demanding season in his life amidst unforeseen challenges, Mason finds solace in the support and prayers offered by the staff and faculty. He acknowledges that these trials are shaping and strengthening him, describing the experience as a refining fire season molded by the Lord's hand. "It is no secret that God calls us through hard things," he adds.

As Mason matures in his faith, his desire to sing songs of exaltation mirrors a profound understanding of worship's impact. "Worship is not just singing on stage. It is a lifestyle. It is Romans Chapter 12. It is bringing glory to the Lord." Amid life's challenges, Mason not only serves as a worship leader but also continues to pursue his call in education as he serves as our SGA President.

Mason's advice to fellow students centers on trusting in the Lord's timing and discerning between good and great opportunities. He emphasizes, "Trust in the Lord and trust in His time. Be careful about what you say yes and no to. Sometimes you have to say no to some good things and wait for God to bring the great things." In essence, Mason's story at Manna U is a testament to the transformative power of education and faith, intertwining to shape a leader dedicated to worship and service.
